

## Boarding Passes Revolutionised

In conjunction with Northwest Airlines, UK based technology company Mobiqu have completely revolutionised the passenger boarding system.

The concept of the paperless boarding pass allows travellers to use their personal handheld devices such as mobile phones when boarding a flight.

This new system, known as an E-Boarding Pass is being piloted for customers travelling non-stop between within the US.

The travel details are received by the device via MMS, email or WAP Push/link message. The device is then scanned before the passenger enters the departure area.
