

Northwest Airlines announces expansion of E-Boarding Passes

This follows a successful test programme that Northwest ran in Indianapolis, Indiana.

E-Boarding Passes enable customers to use mobile phones and other handheld devices for clearing security and boarding [flights](#). A mobile barcode is sent directly to the device in the form of an e-mail, WAP push/link or MMS message.

The service is available for passengers travelling non-stop to cities in the IS from Detroit and Indianapolis.
